

**BRAIN INJURY-HOME AND COMMUNITY BASED SERVICES (BI-HCBS) WAIVER
Specialized Nursing Level of Care (Supported Living Program)**

Stephens Brain Injury Campus is a certified provider of services under the Medicaid BI-HCBS Waiver. All Medicaid applicants for residential services at Stephens Campus must be approved for this waiver and must be on the wait list for Brain Injury Supported Living Program with Colorado Department of Healthcare Policy and Financing (CHCPF).

Eligibility requirements for the Brain Injury Supported Living Program include:

- Brain Injury diagnosis (see approved list)
- Financial requirements (300% of SSI)
- Onset of injury between ages 16-64 years
- Maximized his/her acute and rehabilitation potential
- Continues to require and benefit from at least two specialized support services
- Requires long-term specialized daily assistance that cannot be provided in a nursing facility

In order to access this wait list, you must contact the Single Entry Point (SEP) Agency in the county that the applicant resides. A list of those agencies is included. The applicant may already have a Case Manager with HCBS if you are receiving services in your home. Contact the SEP or your HCBS Case Manager and request a referral to the Brain Injury Waiver-Supported Living Program. Your SEP or HCBS Case Manager must submit a completed Professional Medical Information Page to the Adult HCBS Waiver Coordinator with CHCPF. The Adult HCBS Waiver Coordinator will then determine appropriateness for the BI-Supported Living Program. Your Case Manager from the Single Entry Point (SEP) Agency can tell you if you have been approved and are on the Wait List.
